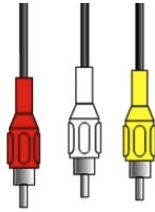
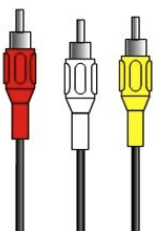


Cables & Connections Guide

AV IN - Connect AV Cables from AV Output port on cable / satellite box to AV input port on the Multimedia Center



AV OUT - Connect AV Cables from AV Output port on the Multimedia Center to AV input port on the TV



HDMI - Connect HDMI cable from HDMI port on the Multimedia Center to the HDMI port on the TV



Ethernet Cable - Connect from router to Multimedia Center

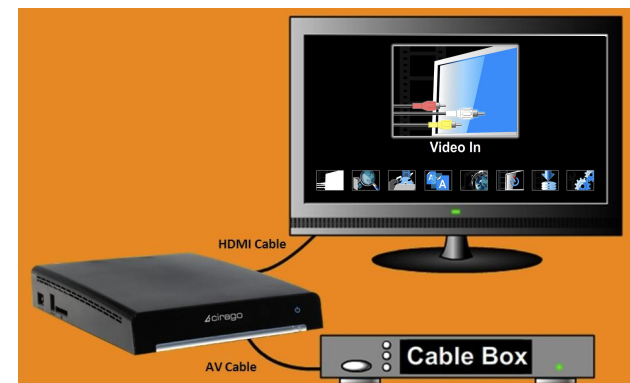


Quick Start Guide

Step 1. Transfer your music, movies and photos from your computer to your Multimedia Center using the USB cable provided. Please make sure that the Multimedia Center is powered on while it is connected to your computer.



Step 2. Connect the Multimedia Center to your TV using the HDMI cable provided. If you have a cable or satellite box from your cable provider, connect it to the Multimedia Center using the AV cables provided to enable the recording and timeshift features.



If you do not see a menu on your screen, press the TV system button on the remote control a few times.

Play content from cameras, USB flash drives, external hard drives or any USB devices. You can also copy files between the Multimedia Center and these devices using COPY button on the remote control or the File Copy menu located in the Home menu.

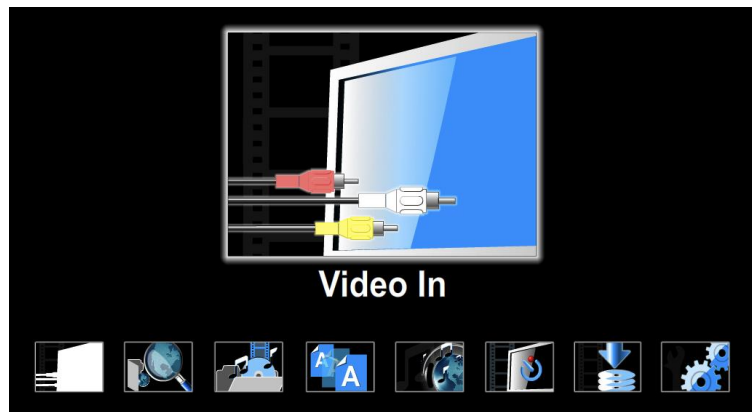


Connect to your network by connecting the Multimedia Center to your router using an ethernet cable. Connect wirelessly using the optional wireless 802.11n adapter (model number CWA300N).



The Home Menu shows you the different features the Multimedia Center provides. Press the HOME button on the remote control to access this menu.

- Video In - Display video from AV input (example: cable / satellite box)
- Browse - Browse and play media files
- Media Library - Search through all the files on the Multimedia Center
- File Copy - Copy Files between the Multimedia Center and connected devices
- Internet Radio - Listen to internet radio stations
- Timer Record - Schedule recordings of TV shows
- P2P - Download torrent files directly to the Multimedia Center
- Setup - Change the settings on the Multimedia Center



Record Live TV by pressing the REC button on the remote control. Schedule future recording times from the Timer Record menu located in the Home menu. You can also record from any device that is connected to the Multimedia Center's AV input (example: digitize your VHS tapes by connecting your VHS player to the Multimedia Center).
